3 - (1) No person shall (a) install a water fitting to convey or receive water supplied by a water undertaker, or alter, disconnect or use such a water fitting; or (b) cause or permit such a water fitting to be installed, altered, disconnected or used, in contravention of the regulations.

<u>NOTE</u> It follows that any persons shall be able to identify any water fitting proposed to be used to ensure that both the fitting, and the manner of its installation, shall meet the requirements of the regulations.

Every fitting and appliance shall be examined to confirm that the model(s) submitted for testing are those identified as being representative of the product(s) listed in the application and to verify that the details provided in the schedule of materials are valid and accurate.

For products applications submitted through the WRAS online portal

Every fitting and appliance shall be examined to confirm that the model(s) submitted for testing are those identified as being representative of the product(s) listed in the Testing and Sample Requirements Document. The 'WA' reference number should be recorded in the report and declaration.

### 5. <u>ACCEPTANCE CRITERIA</u>

For all applications

The model(s) submitted shall be those identified as representative of the product(s) for which approval is being sought and detailed in the application or Testing and Sample Requirements Document.

For products applications submitted via a recognised Test laboratory

The information provided in the schedule of materials must be valid and accurate.
